WHY JOIN AN INTEGRATION PRACTICUM RETREAT?



LIMITED OPTIONS FOR PRACTICAL **PSYCHEDELIC TRAINING**

Currently, the rising demand for psychedelic retreats and experiences outpaces the supply of qualified and experienced guides, facilitators, therapists, tripsitters or integration specialists. Training programs for psychedelic service providers are emerging to address this need, but they face this #1 challenge:

How to provide training with psychedelics when psychedelics are still illegal?

Because of this major limitation, psychedelic training programs are limited to these options:

- Breathwork and cannabis retreats as proxies for the psychedelic experience, which isn't quite the same, but can serve as a basic foundation for working with expanded states of consciousness.
- Legal training in ketamine therapy, for those who meet the academic or professional background requirements, which prepares you to work in a clinical environment.
- Underground psychedelic retreats and workshops, which would not be legal, nor publicized, and involve a level of risk for the organization and participants.
- Offer training retreats in other countries where the psychedelic is not prohibited, such as Jamaica, the Netherlands, and Peru.

INTEREST IN SHAMANIC HEALING OUTPACES CLINICAL

As mainstream interest grows, more people are seeking psychedelic experiences through underground ceremonies and shamanic facilitators, rather than legal ketamine clinics.

The desire to participate in ceremonies with psychoactive plants and fungi, in nature, in community, as a group healing and initiatory experience, remains as steadfast now as in the time of our tribal ancestors.

This social dynamic reveals a disconnect between the psychedelic healing experiences people are seeking and the clinical approach that many psychedelic training programs follow. The 3 main issues that can arise from this disconnect are a school's:

- Inability to effectively address paranormal or shamanic phenomenon that participants of entheogenic ceremonies might encounter, especially disturbing experiences
- Poor recognition of the level of impact the culture of the medicine has on an individual's healing experience
- Absence of appreciation of the force of group intention and prayer when galvanized in the visionary state, that can powerfully facilitate community healing and harmonious relations

WHAT IS AN INTEGRATION **PRACTICUM RETREAT?**

An integration practicum retreat is designed specifically to **support psychedelic professionals in** gaining embodied experience supporting others in preparing for, navigating and integrating entheogenic experiences.

While the vast majority of plant medicine retreats are entirely oriented towards personal healing and transformation, an integration practicum retreat is designed to prepare you to support others in THEIR healing and transformation.

In this practicum retreat, you will learn from indigenous wisdom keepers and seasoned integration coaches. Here are some of to skills you can expect to gain:

- Ancestral shamanic tools and techniques from the Shipibo and Q'ero lineages so that you can increase your ceremony space-holding skills
- Contemporary transformational modalities that anyone can practice, without having to be a licensed therapist, mental health counselor, or medical professional
- Hands-on practice in facilitating integration circles with your retreat cohort so that you might gain the confidence in facilitating group transformation.

Training in trauma-informed care and psychedelic harm reduction is vital and scientific research into psychedelic neuroscience is profoundly insightful. However, the ability to navigate entheogenic states oneself is also essential and cannot be substituted by intellectual knowledge alone.

A traditional community healer, Danilo has been facilitating Huachuma healing ceremonies for the last 5 years.

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

ABOUT THE PLANT MEDICINES



AYAHUASCA

Ayahuasca is a psychoactive brew and ancestral plant medicine made from the Banisteriopsis caapi vine and the leaves of the Psychotria viridis shrub.

The name "ayahuasca" comes from the Quechuan language and means "Vine of the Spirits"; it is used interchangeably to refer to the vine itself, as well as the brew. However, ayahuasca holds an important place in many South American cultures and may be referred to by different names depending on who is using it, including yagé, daime, hoasca and uní. San Pedro (Echinopsis pachanoi) is a tall, fastgrowing cactus native to the Andes mountains. It has long been used in Andean shamanism for its psychedelic properties, and as a treatment of physical ailments. It is still commonly used in Peru (known as Huachuma), Bolivia (known as Achuma), and Ecuador (known as Aguacolla).

The long-lasting mystical and sensory experience that results from ingesting San Pedro can be used for personal transformation, spiritual exploration, or even healing.

HUACHUMA

ABOUT THE SACRED SITES





The world-renowned, sacred site of Machu Picchu is located above the Wilka Nota river and is home to the altar of Apu Salkantay, the most important of the Incas' spirit gods.

The citadel, which was built in the 15th century, is said to represent the crystal condor as it is built out of granite in the shape of a condor. The myth goes that the crystal condor carries the souls of humans to the sun of divine origins.

At this sacred site, you will be able to connect to the energies of the Incan traditions and understand their reverence for the sun, moon, and Mother Earth.

MACHU PICCHU



AGUAS CALIENTES

Aguas Calientes is a town in the Urubamba River Valley that lies at the seat of the Machu Picchu district.

The town is home to natural hot baths that provide some well-needed respite after traversing the mountains of the Sacred Valley.

Accessible only by train, Aguas Calientes is located on the banks of the Vilcanota River and is flanked by lush, green mountain walls that rise to the height of 400 meters on either side.

Machu Picchu is just a 30 minute bus ride from Aguas Calientes, making the little town the arrival point by train for people who want to visit the World Heritage Site.



Ollantaytambo, located in the north of the Sacred Valley, is a living Inca town, overlooked by an impressive ancient citadel. The mountainside is home to elaborate terraces. temples, pyramids and astronomical observatories, showcasing the Incas' highly advanced understanding of architecture, astronomy, and engineering.

Ollantaytambo was a military, agricultural, astronomical and religious center, and has a number of ceremonial centers, including the temple of the sun and the temple of the water.

OLLANTAYTAMBO

The Andean town of Pisac, nestled in the southern end of the Sacred Valley, is known for its Incan ruins and impressive market, which sells produce, textiles, and souvenirs. The locals of Pisac are known for keeping tradition, with many of the women adorning the traditional Andean outfits. Visitors enjoy views of the spectacular Incan ruins which cling to the cliffs above the town, made up of a large complex of terraces, residences, guard posts, watchtowers, and a ceremonial center. Pisac also boasts Comunitario de Pisac, a museum full of ceramics and traditional textiles produced by local Quechua communities, a botanical garden, and the mythical rock formation, Nusta Encantada.

PISAC

50km Northwest of Cusco and 3,500m high lies Moray, an enigmatic archeological site containing ancient Inca ruins.

The vast, spectacular ruins are composed of three groups of circular terraces (muyus in Quechua) stretching to 30m deep. The terraces' design, depth and orientation toward the sun and wind has created microclimates and temperature differences of up to 5 degrees celsius between the top and bottom.

Archeologists and anthropologists have long debated the purpose of these ruins, and the most widely-held belief is that the terraces were used as an experimental farm.

These ruins are a prime example of the Incas' deep understanding of their surrounding environment and how to use it to capitalize on the natural resources they had at their disposal.



Several houses include fireplaces, comfortable sofas, long dining tables, and fully equipped kitchens. Wifi is available in communal areas.





TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group transportation to the retreat center has been arranged from a meeting point in Cusco. To ensure that you start the retreat in good form, we recommend arriving in Cusco a few days before the retreat.

This will give you time to adjust to the high altitude (11,000 feet), which may cause altitude sickness for some people. Drinking coca tea, as well as chewing on coca leaves can reduce the symptoms of altitude sickness. Raw lemon juice can relieve symptoms

This will also give you an opportunity to visit noteworthy historical sites in Cusco that are not included in the sacred site tours that are part of the retreat program

• Expect warm days with strong midday sun, followed by chilly evenings, along with the possibility of rain. Bring a raincoat, swimsuit for hot springs, outdoor hiking apparel, comfortable clothes for ceremonies, and warm layers. A more detailed pack list will be sent upon confirmation

COVID

Our COVID-19 policy is to comply with all national laws and we ask that participants respect our host country's COVID policies. Peru currently requires masks in public enclosed spaces and on public transportation.

Before boarding the plane, you'll need to complete an **electronic** affidavit of health.

Before boarding the plane, all travelers may show a vaccination card with the required doses completed up to 14 days before the flight

Otherwise, those travelers not fully vaccinated must show a negative PCR test issued up to 48 hours before boarding

If you arrive early, we ask that you minimize the risk of Covid-19 by avoiding large crowds and using masks in indoor spaces so that the retreat can remain COVID-free.



WHAT ARE THE DATES OF THE RETREAT?

The 10-Day Soul Purpose Vision Quest Retreat in Sacred Valley, Peru begins on Sunday, March 19, 2023 and ends on Wednesday, March 29, 2023

HOW MUCH DOES THE RETREAT COST?

Early Bird Pricing is \$6,597 USD for a double occupancy room. Early Bird Pricing ends on December, 21, 2022 at 11:59PM.

Standard Pricing is \$7,597 USD for a double occupancy room.

Single Occupancy Rooms can be booked for an additional \$1150 USD.

DOES THE RETREAT INCLUDE ANY INTEGRATION CALLS?

In addition to the 10 days spent in Peru's sacred valley, we will have six (6) x 90minute Zoom calls on Saturdays at 10AM Pacific to support your retreat preparation and integration.

WHEN ARE THE LIVE CALLS?

There will be live 90-minute Zoom calls on Saturday at 10AM Pacific in the two weeks leading up to, and in the four weeks following the retreat. All calls will be recorded and available to you are replays. Dates and topics are as follows:

WHAT TIME ZONES ARE MOST COMPATIBLE WITH THE LIVE CALLS?

Though Lorna is based in Spain, the vast majority of our guest faculty and students are located in the United States, so time zone compatibility is most aligned with North American time zones.



WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT FROM OTHER PLANT MEDICINE RETREATS?

This retreat is specifically designed for plant medicine facilitators, ceremony spaceholders, entheogenic church leaders and integration specialists. You will:

- Learn and practice a variety of ancestral and contemporary tools for entheogenic healing
- Practice holding peer-led integration circles, so that you can build the confidence to host your own circles at home
- Visit sacred Incan sites and power portals to invoke the divine guidance of the ancients to support the unfolding of your destiny
- Spend the entire retreat in focused healing and activation of your soul **purpose** through medicine ceremony and shamanic practices
- Make lifelong friendships with other emerging leaders of the Renaissance and build a powerful support network

Finally, many Western operated retreats are run by Western facilitators and team members, with one or two poorly-compensated, token indigenous healers. More than half the SPVQ team are indigenous and Peruvian co-facilitators who are being compensated at par with the Western facilitation team.

WHY JOIN A PLANT MEDICINE PRACTICUM RETREAT IN PERU?

Regular plant medicine retreats are usually focused on personal healing and spiritual growth. However, if you are an existing or aspiring psychedelic therapist or integration coach, cultivating hands-on skills and experience so that you can safely work with entheogenic clients is a must.

Unfortunately, with psychedelics and entheogenic plant medicines being illegal in most locales, it's very difficult to gain this experience above ground. Indeed, many people hone their skills in underground plant medicines circles and entheogenic churches, but often these environments lack any formal training.

With the expansion of the Psychedelic Renaissance, more people are seeking psychedelic experiences, so the need for qualified and experienced integration specialists is real and rising.

This retreat offers a unique opportunity to cultivate integration skills bundled into an unforgettable, once-in-a-lifetime, cultural experience.



WHY IS THIS RETREAT SO EXPENSIVE?

This is a **practicum retreat** for leaders and professionals who have entheogenic experience who wish to offer integration services. This is a high-touch retreat at a high-end retreat center, supported by 9 facilitators - which include **5 wisdom** keepers.

We have **4 Western trainers** flying in from different parts of the world who will teach specific integration modalities so that participants can gain and embody the skills needed to work with entheogenic clients.

These trainings are what we teach in the **Plant Spirit School Integration Coach Certification program**, and cannot easily be replicated by local Peruvians who are unfamiliar with our philosophy and frameworks related to trauma-informed care and psychedelic harm reduction.

We make sure that our indigenous wisdom keepers and local service partners are well-compensated. Finally, we allocate **10% of profits towards our Sacred Reciprocity Program**, which includes charitable contributions to local NGOs.

WHY IS THIS RETREAT SO EXPENSIVE? cont.

As a **small, privately-owned social enterprise**, EntheoNation is committed to the principles of **Sacred Commerce**, ensuring that the abundance we generate is **not hoarded, but shared equitably** with our community so that the company is sustainable, everyone is paid a meaningful wage, AND we can give back.

If you are seeking a more economical retreat, we would gladly refer you to other retreat operators. For a one-week plant medicine retreat priced around \$1500 that **isn't illegal**, expect rustic South American accommodations.

Any one-week retreat that is less than \$1500 may also lack appropriate safety **measures**, in addition to the comforts of plumbing (imagine seeking an open latrine that is a hole in the jungle crawling with insects at night during ceremony).

Beds might be infested by bed bugs or scabies, which are common in the tropics (been there, done that). Or you may have to provision your own hammock (by far the safer option).

You can find a wide range of retreats on **Retreat Guru**, even in locales where the plant medicines are not legal.

DO I NEED TO HAVE EXPERIENCED PSYCHEDELICS TO JOIN THIS RETREAT?

This retreat is a practicum retreat for those who have or wish to grow professional careers in the Psychedelic Renaissance. It is designed to support psychedelic therapists, facilitators and integration providers in cultivating the skills to work with entheogenic clients.

We prioritize applicants who have attended entheogenic ceremonies on a regular basis for at least one year. This is because we feel that it is essential that psychedelic facilitators and integration providers are familiar with psychedelic states of consciousness before working with others in this capacity.

While it is possible to attain altered states of consciousness achieved through other modalities we find that the ayahuasca experience is a distinct entheogenic experience and we do not have the capacity to support newcomers to psychedelics in a retreat designed for experienced professionals.

WHAT IS YOUR BUSINESS MODEL?

We are a small, private, for-profit social enterprise. We are not a volunteer-run nonprofit organization that relies on individual donors and grants in order to operate. All of our faculty are compensated a fair market value for their wisdom and expertise. Furthermore, our team of dedicated staff who have worked around the clock for months to bring this program to life is also paid a fair market wage for their labor.

Like most companies, we keep our valued team employed throughout the calendar year, even though the business only brings in meaningful revenue during major event launches and program enrollment periods, which take place twice a year. Therefore, we need to charge rates that can keep the business running and provide our team with the stable employment they deserve.

We are also not a venture-funded initiative supported by high-tech or cannabis capital. All revenues generated from the sale of courses, programs and retreats go back into the company to create new, educational offers. EntheoNation is a self-funded business that follows the principles of Sacred Commerce, whereby the Founder is the last person paid.



Nobody is being pressured or forced to service this retreat against their will, or as an indentured servant. All wisdom keepers and co-facilitators are being paid the compensation that they have requested, an amount that is both fair, and above local market rates. Our wisdom keepers willingly participate in this retreat with love, joy, and gratitude to share their culture with people from so far away.

ARE THE PLANT MEDICINES BEING EXPLOITED TO PRODUCE THIS **RETREAT?**

The rainforest is not being destroyed in order to produce the medicine that is being served in this retreat. The Maestros make the medicine by hand, with love, according to their tradition, using both plants from their own garden, along with wildcrafted plants from the forest.

The Maestros mostly serve their local Shipibo community, and not ayahuasca tourists en masse, as high volume retreat centers do. Nor do they do they ship ayahuasca in bulk to customers in other countries.

Huachuma cactus grows abundantly in the Andes and is not being depleted.

WHERE DO THE PROFITS FROM THIS RETREAT GO?

As a business, our #1 priority is to be able to sustainably offer programs that bring value to our customers year after year.

All profits go towards covering the expenses of running the next retreat, which include securing the retreat venue and food, payroll and travel expenses for all cofacilitators and wisdom keepers; payment to our sacred sites tour operator, and the entire back-office team that is responsible for web development, graphic design, administration and customer service. It is easily 100+ hours of work to produce and deliver a high-touch retreat in another country.

10% of profits also goes towards local charitable contributions, as part of our Sacred Reciprocity Program.

The Founder, Lorna Liana, choose to derive her salary, firstly, from business coaching and creative agency clients, and lastly, after her team and partners are paid, from offers related to sacred plant medicines.

YOU USE THE WORD "SHAMAN" AND "SHAMANIC" FREQUENTLY. ISN'T "SHAMAN" AND "SHAMANISM" TECHNICALLY FROM SIBERIA?

A "shaman" can be defined as an earth-centered community guide and healer who travels between worlds to gather and transmit information that helps individuals and the community. A "shaman" is a person regarded as having access to, and influence in the world of benevolent and malevolent spirits. A shaman acts as an intermediary between the natural and supernatural worlds, using magic to cure illness, foretell the future, control spiritual and elemental forces, and affect outcomes in the physical world. Typically, such people enter a trance state during rituals of divination and healing.

It's important to note that not all medicine ceremony leaders are doctors and healers. Because few people in English-speaking society know what "pajé", "onanya", "mara'akame", or "curandero" means, and most understand the concept of "shaman", we've chosen intentionally to use the word "shaman" in our literature in order to communicate this concept, for lack of a better alternative word.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PSYCHEDELICS-ASSISTED **PSYCHOTHERAPY AND PSYCHEDELIC INTEGRATION?**

Psychedelics-assisted psychotherapy is a therapeutic modality which takes place in a clinical setting under the supervision of academically trained specialists. It centers around the ingestion of a psychedelic substance by participants to treat a myriad of conditions and typically includes both preparatory and integrative sessions.

Psychedelic integration is the process of taking ideas, imagery, memories, and epiphanies that may have come up during the journey and implementing them so that they may be applied to everyday life. This may be done by both therapists and coaches.



WHY IS IT SO UNUSUAL FOR A RETREAT TO OFFER POST CEREMONY INTEGRATION SUPPORT?

Integration support is a responsibility that requires certain skills and training to do well, that anyone with the interest and commitment can learn. Some ceremony facilitators do offer integration packages but many do not. High-end retreat centers like Soltara in Costa Rica offer ongoing integration support.

The ones that do typically have a psychotherapy or coaching background. Others, such as indigenous ceremony leaders, shamanic healers, and medicine musicians may not be well-resourced or trained to offer ongoing support. Organizing and leading ceremonies and retreats is already a lot of work; many have day jobs, and thus do not have the extra capacity. Many facilitators do not feel it is their responsibility to provide integration support.

Ceremony guardians and helpers, volunteer members of the community who assist the ceremony, often do not have the skills or capacity to provide ongoing integration support, either. What happens all too frequently is that participants are left to process the insights, emotions, and traumas activated by the ceremony experience entirely on their own.

WHOSE RESPONSIBILITY IS IT TO PROVIDE INTEGRATION SUPPORT?

Due to the nature of the psychedelic experience, lack of adequate integration can potentiate past traumas leaving individuals grappling with new personal challenges triggered by the ceremony itself. Having a referral network of trained integration providers is imperative for the safety and well-being of participants.

Underground ceremony facilitators are often ill-equipped to provide ongoing support since their primary focus is hosting and leading ceremonies. Ceremony assistants are typically members of the community who volunteer their time to support a ceremony, and not to offer ongoing integration support to participants.

WHY IS THERE SO MUCH FOCUS ON PSYCHEDELIC INTEGRATION?

In traditional communities, there is no need for additional integration support as the culture itself is integrative. The ceremony participants receive the integration support from the communities they live in. In comparison, Western society is not set up to help people integrate profound transformational experiences. The Western materialist paradigm rejects the experience of non-ordinary states of consciousness, highlighting the demand for more trained specialists in the Western world.

WHY AREN'T THERE ENOUGH PSYCHEDELIC INTEGRATION PROVIDERS?

Decriminalization and legalization of psychedelics as breakthrough treatments for mental health are expanding around the world. As a result, **the current demand for psychedelic therapy is growing rapidly**, with patients of legal ketamine clinics experiencing long wait times. Because psychedelic medicine remains illegal in most locales, many are turning to underground facilitators, plant medicine ceremonies, and retreats.

With the increase in interest for psychedelics, there is a proportional increase in demand for integration support. At the moment, there is a bottleneck with notable organizations that are training psychedelic therapists - they **are not graduating people fast enough**. This is why there aren't enough qualified people to meet the increasing demand for psychedelic medicine.

The promise of psychedelics to address the global mental health crisis is only as strong as the availability of qualified integration specialists who can support clients through the most transformational experience of their lives.
